Riverside City College and Moreno Valley College are separate colleges and the courses that are approved for IGETC may vary. Students who wish to take courses at another institution and apply them to IGETC should always first consult with a counselor to make sure the course will fulfill the intended requirement.
A minimum of $60 \cup C / C S U$ transferable units are required for upper-division transfer. Courses cannot be double-counted to satisfy more than one area, even if a course is listed in more than one area (The only exception to this is the US History, Constitution and Government requirement, which is not part of IGETC).
